J&D's COMMITMENT TO CLEANLINESS

At J&D, we have always prided ourselves on our high standards for cleanliness, and given how many of our guests have appreciated these efforts, we know it's important to you too! We are proud to share our plan for providing you with a safe space to practice social distancing while enjoying the great outdoors.

TEMPORARY CHANGES TO OPERATIONS

On June 12th, Columbia County enters the Green Zone, which is a relaxed phase of state-mandated restrictions. We have updated our operations, and the following changes remain:

- *State Law mandates that individuals must practice social distancing of at least 6 feet.*
- Our camp office is open following social distancing guidelines. Because of the small nature of our office, only two customers may be inside the camp office at a time. A **Red X** on the floor will direct customers where to stand as they wait in line. If two customers are already in the office, please wait outside until one exits. While we have installed a sneeze guard, state law requires that masks must still be worn inside. Please use the hand sanitizer station before coming into the office.
- To reduce time in the office, you may call ahead to prepay for your site and complete the check-in process over the phone.
- While the bathrooms in the green building are now open, the blue bathhouse will remain closed. Hand sanitizer stations are installed outside each door, which should be used before you enter the building.
- The laundry room is open! Please limit your time in the laundry room to starting and collecting your wash. A hand sanitizer station is available inside the laundry room near the door.
- In addition to our normal strict cleaning and security measures, we are disinfecting all touch points throughout the park on a regular basis: full-hookup areas, site picnic tables, the change machine, door handles, laundry room, etc. We will not have reserve gloves or other cleaning products and encourage you to bring these products from home.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES YOU CAN TAKE

- **WASH YOUR HANDS** frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- **AVOID CLOSE CONTACT** with people who are sick.
- Masks must be worn inside of any building and should be worn when speaking with any of our staff.
- **AVOID TOUCHING YOUR FACE**, especially your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- **STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK** with cold or flu-like symptoms.

WHAT YOU CAN ENJOY WHILE YOU ARE HERE

- We are blessed with fresh air and outdoor activities that can be enjoyed even during social distancing! Remember, the great outdoors is not cancelled! You will be able to walk and/or bike around the roads and elsewhere on the property. You are not required to wear a mask when outside with your family. A fire will be a great opportunity to relax, have a cook-out and enjoy the calmness of nature.
- Playgrounds are open. We have placed hand sanitizer stations at the new playground and ask you to follow social distancing guidelines. We are sanitizing the playground daily.
- The dog park is open to one family at a time. Please use the hand sanitizer station before entering the dog park.
- You may use the basketball court, volleyball or horseshoe area if you bring your own equipment.
- The pond is available for fishing while using social distancing. For those of you with a fishing license you may also go into the trout stocked creek.
- The Cree-Mee-Freeze across the street is open for hot meals and delicious cold desserts!
- Sundays at 10:30 there will be Non-Denominational Church Services in the Green Building. Family units can sit together at the tables or on chairs. All others should distance themselves by 6 feet. Masks should be worn.

The Pool

With Columbia County entering the green zone, we will be opening the swimming pool on June 12th. Because of the small nature of the pool and continued COVID-19 restrictions there will be modifications to the pool. As this is an unprecedented situation, we may be making modifications as time goes on. We ask for your patience and cooperation.

1. Pool guest must bring their own chairs
2. Please use the hand sanitizing station before entering
3. There will be a limit of 40 people allowed within the pool area at a time.
4. Please do not use the pool for sunbathing only when people are waiting to get into the pool.
5. You may not leave your chairs to save a spot if you are leaving for an extended period of time.
6. Non-family units must remain 6 feet apart
7. Masks do not need to be worn at the pool
8. A spirit of cooperation and turn taking will be needed for everyone to have an opportunity to enjoy the pool.
9. Please do not yell at our lifeguards who are following CDC guidelines.
